




## Where Funding Came From


We do not recieve any funding from the government and are not affiliated with other humane societies or national pet organizations.




## Where Funding Was Spent





#### From the Executive Director

We are so excited that our Live Release Rate (or Save Rate) for 2022 is 98.8%! There are a couple ways to calculate this rate. We used ASPCA's, which takes the number of live animals that left the building divided by the number of pets we brought in.

In my eight years at CHS we have always had great save rates, in the upper 90th percentiles. Being at nearly 99% is quite the accomplishment especially considering the increase in special needs medical cases that we have fought for this year.

We couldn't have done this without several key players. One, our medical staff, including our wonderful Medical Director. Second, all our staff working tirelessly to ensure that optimal care is given to each animal. Third, our amazing volunteers who help us take care of our facility and animals each day. Finally, and most importantly, YOU. Your support means we can go the extra mile - whether that is additional surgeries, diagnostic testing like x rays



and ultrasounds, bloodwork, or even just more time to heal and find a forever home.
